

Curriculum **Daily Routines** We strike a careful balance between adult-led and childinitiated learning. We plan experiences for the children every week based on their interests and they also have time for focussed activities in small groups. **Mathematics** We LOVE maths in Nursery! We use guidance from The National Centre for the Excellence in The Teaching of Mathematics (NCETM) to deliver a balanced curriculum and prepare the children for the White Rose approach used in Reception Class. Reading Sharing stories and reading books is an important part of Nursery experience, aiming to foster a love of books and provide pre-reading skills. We are delighted to deliver Read Write Inc. phonics in Nursery and most importantly the children love it! It gives them a real head-start when they enter Reception class.

- St Paul's Community Primary School & Nursery Admission Form
- Ethnic Origin Form
- Emergency Contact Details Form
- Permissions form (Data Protection)
- Early Years Entitlement 3 & 4 year old funding Parent Declaration Form
- Contract for invoiced hours (if applicable)
- Home-School Agreement

When you have done this Mr Gough will contact you to talk about your child and how we can best support their needs.



In Nursery it is our aim to have your child socially, emotionally and academically prepared for their Reception year. We work closely with the Reception team to make sure that your little one has the best possible head start we can give them.

Our children all experience a complimentary curriculum of Mathematics, Phonics, and the "Plan, Do, Review" approach to child initiated learning.

It is important to remember that all admissions to Reception Class are handled by **Lincolnshire County Council**. Our Nursery children are not automatically given a place.

Parents must complete a preference form and return it to Lincolnshire County Council by a set date each year.
