Everything you loved in Year 3 will still be


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














In Year 4, we will be ensuring we all know our times tables and can read and write longer, more interesting sentences.

Uniform- will be the same as Year 3.

- Hair accessories should be in blue or yellow and be modest in size
- Please ensure that your child wears a sensible black school shoe. Trainers are not permitted as part of the school uniform. Socks should be white or black.





P.E. Kit-remember to bring this!

- Black shorts for indoors and a T shirt in the child's house colour.
- Plimsolls for indoors / trainers for outdoors
- Winter tracksuit including warm top / fleece
- All items of clothing should be named and kept in a named PE bag in the cloakroom.

Children change for PE in their classrooms, under qualified supervision. For safety reasons, watches must be removed and earrings removed or taped before all lessons.
