

School Behaviour policy.

We have now updated our school behaviour policy which you can find on the school website.



We will now be using class DOJO as our behaviour reward system.

What is Class Dojo?

Class Dojo is an interactive reward system that allows parents to see what and how well their children are achieving in school. It informs parents when their child is rewarded with a Dojo point, and what it is for. Dojo points are given for a variety of reasons and encourage children to work hard and participate fully. As a class the children and the teacher agree which behaviours should be awarded a Dojo point. Our school values are also rewarded through Dojo. Children then collect dojo points to spend in the school DOJO shop from pencils/bookmarks/notepads/games/film afternoon/extra playtime/afternoon tea etc.
