They will be awarded Dojo points for producing great work and demonstrating our school values. They can trade their Dojo Points for treats in the school shop!




Meals and Snacks

The Early Years Framework



We follow the **Early Years Foundation Stage Statutory Framework** and work towards all of the Areas of Learning and Development within it. The framework focuses on play and exploration, active learning and creativity and critical thinking.

In Reception we work towards Early Learning Goals. These summarise the knowledge, skills and understanding that children should have gained by the end of their Foundation Stage.

Phonics

Read Write Inc.

We are proud to be a **Read Write Inc.** phonics school. Children in Reception class will learn a new sound every day and learn to read by blending sounds together using 'Fred Talk'.




Mathematics

Children will have an adult-led maths session every day.

We follow the **White Rose Early Years Scheme of Learning**. This scheme is in line with the Statutory Framework and offers a rich curriculum. It also provides a seamless transition for our children into Year 1.




