Weather Warning!!

Next week the Met Office has issued an amber warning for extreme heat across large parts of England between Sunday and Tuesday, with temperatures potentially soaring above 30 degrees.

School will remain open but we will be taking the following steps to ensure the childre stay safe and comfort needs can be met:

- If you need to make some adaptations to the school uniform this wil be ok.
- -If children do not have a sun hat they will net be allowed outside.
- -We will limit outdoor activites to shaded areas and classrooms will be available for the children to go in at liunchtime to avoid the heat of the day.
- -There will be no outside ball games played to prevent heat exhaustion and children will be encouraged not to run around during break and lunchtime
- -Children will have access to water all day and fill their waterbottles up whenever they need.
