
Meet Ms. Haresign





- Please feel free to ask the year one team any questions you may have




Reading

- At the beginning of the year the children will take a star reader assessment, which will asses their reading level
- They will be given a reading book based upon their level to read at home
- Please read with your child as often as possible, ideally 15 minutes five times a week. When you have listened to them read, please sign their record or, if they have read independently, they can sign their own!
- A adult in school will aim to read with your child at least once a week



Home Learning

- Please listen to your child read at home at least 5 times a week for 15 minutes
- 10 weekly spellings will be sent out for each child, which will follow the spelling rule they have leant in school that week. These will be tested in school
- English and Maths homework will be sent home on a two week cycle: one week English, the following week
 Maths and so on
- Each term a jigsaw sheet will be sent home, which will give some project ideas linked to there topic
- Home learning will always be sent home on a Friday an will need to be returned by the following Thursday



Uniform

The wearing of school uniform is strongly encouraged and contributes to a feeling identity and collective pride in our school community.

Our St Paul's uniform is as follows:

- Blue cardigan or sweatshirt with school logo
- Black/grey skirt, pinafore dress, trousers, or knee length shorts
- Collard shirt or polo shirt in white
- Yellow or blue gingham striped dress during the summer
- Hair accessories should be in blue or yellow and be modest in size
- Please ensure that your child wears a sensible black school. Trainers are not permitted as part of the school uniform. Socks should be white or black

PE kit

- Black shorts for indoors and a t shirt in the child's house colour
- Plimsolls for indoors / trainers for outdoors
- Winter tracksuit including warm top / fleece
- All items of clothing should be named and kept in a named PE bag in the classroom

Children change for PE in their classrooms, under qualified supervision. For safety reason, watches and earrings must be removed before all lessons.



Extra uniform information

- All children should be provided with a sun hat during the summer term and should have sunscreen applied before school, please.
- Please ensure that a suitable coat is worn at all times as children do work and play outside in all weathers. A fleece jacket with school logo is also available to purchase
- Additional footwear is recommended for outdoor learning days and outdoor clubs thought out the year
- Don't forget that ALL clothing and PE kit must be named please
