



Dear Nursery Parents and Carers,

This letter is to inform you that our Nursery will be **reopening for normal provision** from Tuesday 12th January 2021.

The changes to our session times will be going ahead as previously notified. This means that:

- **If your child starts Reception this September their session time will be 8.30am to 11.30am.**
- **If your child starts Reception in September 2022 or September 2023, their session time will be 12.30pm to 3.30pm.**
- **30 hour funded children can continue to attend for both sessions.**

The Trust have asked me to make you all aware of the following:

- We are not able to guarantee that social distancing can be maintained in the setting.
- The provision offered may not be of the same nature that your child is used to.
- The Nursery is being reopened in line with Government guidance and that this may change at any time.

If you do choose to keep your child at home during this period we will still be offering the following:

- Live story time and catch-up on Zoom at 9.30am and 2.30pm each day
- A weekly check-in phone call from a member of the team to keep you up to date and answer any questions.
- Easy, daily communication through Tapestry. Message staff or share your child's home learning by simply adding your own observation in their journal.

If you decide to bring your child to Nursery please note the following:

- The Nursery gate will be open from **8.30am to 8.40am** for the morning session and from **12.30pm to 12.40pm** for the afternoon session. **There is no late admittance after this time. Please do not take your child to the school office if you find the gate is closed.**
- Children **must** arrive at Nursery in a clean nappy / pull-ups.
- Staff will be wearing face coverings from drop-off and pick-up times. You **must** put on a face coving as soon as you enter the school premises. **Please do not approach the Nursery door without a face covering.**
